



INMED Accounting & Bookkeeping Policy: Gift Acceptance

1. INMED solicits and accepts donations that are consistent in supporting its mission, core programs, and special projects.
2. Donations will generally be accepted from individuals, partnerships, corporations, foundations, government agencies, or other entities.
3. INMED reserves the right to use any contribution wherever most needed, thus allowing INMED to strengthen the long-term health systems that are vital to vulnerable people around the world. INMED commits to spend donations in the most productive, efficient way possible. In the case of donor-restricted funds, INMED will use the funds as designated by the grantor.
4. In the course of its regular fundraising activities, INMED may accept donations of money, real property, personal property, stock, and in-kind services.
5. INMED reserves the right to review certain types of gifts prior to acceptance due to the special liabilities they may pose to INMED. Examples of gifts which will be subject to review include, but are not limited to, gifts of real property, gifts of personal property, and gifts of securities.
6. INMED employees, volunteers, and Board Members may not accept personal gifts, except nominal gifts valued at less than \$50, on the behalf of INMED that may influence their decision making.
